

# **Ultra-Processed Foods Linked to Higher Risks of Cancer: New Study**

with access to money, have little time, and no adult supervision whatsoever, a trip to the supermarket would probably look something like this: you head straight for the packaged food section and dump instant noodles into your basket, followed by a bunch of sugary snacks, soda, and then grab some cornflakes. And just before you reluctantly decide to sprinkle the basket with some sad-looking vegetables and fruits to convince yourself to eat healthy, that shiny packet of potato chips that costs way less catches your attention.

The problem here is that most of what you've bought is ultra-processed food — packaged products industrially manufac-tured, chemically or physically transformed, readyto-eat, affordable and aggressively advertised.

Now, we're not one to judge, and you don't have



to feel guilty about the choices you make - just more conscious.

As cheap and convenient as they are, these ultra-processed foods (UPFs) only improve your life on the surface while wreaking havoc within your body. Ahead of World Cancer Day, a recent study led by the Imperial College London has revealed that consuming UPFs in excess could be linked to an increased risk of developing and

dying from cancer.

Owing to the high content of salt, fat, sugar and artificial additives in them, UPFs have previously been associated with greater risks of obesity, type 2 diabetes and cardiovascular disease. But this recent study is the comprehensive assessment of the correlations between them and cancer. Collecting data on the diets of 200,000 middle-aged adult participants, the researchers health over 10 years, looking at the risk of developing any cancer overall as well as the specific risk of developing 34 types of cancer. They also looked at the risk of people dying from cancer. The results showed that

higher consumption of UPFs was associated with a greater risk of developing cancer overall - specifically ovarian and brain cancers. It was also associated with an increased risk of dying from these cancers. For every 10% increase in UPF in a person's diet, there was an increased incidence of 2% for cancer overall and a 19% increase for ovarian cancer specifically. Further, each 10% increase in ultra-processed food consumption was also linked to increased mortality for cancer overall by 6%, alongside a 16% increase for breast cancer and a 30% increase for ovarian cancer.

Tikon's latest fullframe lens is its most versatile yet with a whopping 14.2x optical zoom that covers the 28-400mm focal length. That optical zoom range beats any other fullframe lens and smartphone today - not counting digital zooms like Samsung's 30-100x Space Zoom.

Optically, the Z 28-400mm f/4-8 VR is unlikely to be one of the best Nikon Z lenses – it's not a 'S' lens after all (Nikon's nomenclature for its professional lenses), but it certainly is the most versatile and could be the only lens you need to take traveling.

At its wide end, the 28-400mm is like the perspective of your phone's main camera – ideal for everyday observations, but its 14.2x optical zoom goes way beyond any other on the market, extending up to 400mm. That's plenty close enough for wildlife photos or capturing details of landmarks you simply can't get close to.



## **RECIPE: CHICKEN POT PIE**

## **INGREDIENTS:**

1 pound skinless, boneless chicken breast halves - cubed

1 cup sliced carrots

1 cup frozen green peas 1/2 cup sliced celery

? cup butter ? cup chopped onion

? cup all-purpose flour ½ teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon black pepper

1/4 teaspoon celery seed 1 3/4 cups chicken broth

? cup milk

2 (9 inch) unbaked pie crusts

## **DIRECTIONS:**

Gather all ingredients. Preheat the oven to 425 degrees F



(220 degrees C.) Combine chicken, carrots, peas, and

celery in a saucepan; add water to cover and bring to a boil. Boil for 15 minutes, then remove from the heat and drain.

While the chicken is cooking, melt butter in another saucepan over

medium heat. Add onion and cook until soft and translucent, 5 to 7 minutes. Stir in flour, salt, pepper, and celery seed Slowly stir in chicken broth and milk.

Reduce heat to medium-low and simmer until thick, 5 to 10 minutes. Remove from heat and set aside. Place chicken and vegetables in the bottom pie crust. Pour hot liquid mixture over top. Cover with top crust, seal the edges, and cut away any excess dough. Make several small slits in the top crust to allow steam to escape.

Bake in the preheated oven until pastry is golden brown and filling is bubbly, 30 to 35 minutes. Cool for 10 minutes before serving.
