Jammu and Kashmir Anti-Corruption Bureau received a complaint alleging therein that public servant namely Chuni Lal, Patwari Patwar Halqa Dansal, demanded illegal gratification from the complainant for providing demarcation report. The accused Chuni Lal, Patwari, Patwar Halqa Dansal, demanded the bribe amounting to ?1,00,000 from the complainant for providing report of demarcation and after negotiation, the accused Chuni Lal has agreed to receive ?75,000 and demanded 1st installment of ?25,000 as bribe. However, the complainant could not arrange ?25,000 as 1st installment and instead he managed to arrange ?20, 000 only. Since, the complainant didn't want to pay bribe he approached ACB for taking legal action against the accused public servant under law. On receipt of the complaint, a discreet verification was conducted, which corroborated the demand of bribe by the public servant concerned and accordingly, a case FIR No. 15/2025 U/S 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 was registered in Police Station ACB Jammu and investigation taken up. During the course of investigation, a trap team headed by Gazetted rank officer was constituted. The team laid a successful trap and accused public servant was caught red-handed while demanding and accepting bribe amount of ?20,000 from the complainant in the presence of independent witnesses. The accused was arrested on the spot by the ACB team after following due process of law. The bribe money was also recovered from his possession in presence of independent witnesses associated with the trap team. Moreover, searches were also conducted in the office and in-laws house of the accused in presence of independent witnesses and Magistrates.Further investigation of the instant case is going on.

Charge drug dealers with murder when overdose cause of death: Rajeev Charak

Bharatiya Janata Party Jammu & Kashmir Vice President Rajeev Rajput Charak visited the Rajiv Nagar, Narwal area and held a serious discussion with local residents over the open and unchecked sale of heroin ('chitta') in the locality. Expressing deep concern over the growing drug menace, he highlighted the grim future that awaits the next generation if immediate action is not taken. Charak stated: "Every day,

a young life is lost to a drug overdose — every day, a home loses its light. The drug trade in Rajiv Nagar, Narwal is operating without fear. This silent genocide — who is responsible for it? Every silence another death."Raising a strong and critical question, he asked: "When medical reports clearly cite overdose as the cause of death, why aren't the drug dealers being charged with

murder?" Calling the crisis not just a social issue but a "silent genocide," Charak stressed the need for a unified and decisive public movement against the drug menace. "This death dance has spiralled out of control. This is no longer the time to merely depend on the government or police — it is time for society to rise, united and determined," he asserted.

Expressing profound empathy for the plight of youth and their families, he added: "Most families today have only one child. Parents raise them with love and dreams only to lose them to the poison of drugs in their youth. In the end, the same parents are forced to perform the last rites of their only son. What greater social tragedy could there be?"

He cited alarming figures: "Last year alone, over 600 youth died due to drug abuse in Jammu & Kashmir - and these are just official figures. The actual number is likely much higher. In Jammu district, an average of over 30 overdose cases are reported each month." Charak called

upon religious, social, youth organizations and the media to take the lead in this crucial fight: "This fight is not just against drugs — it is a fight for life. Every citizen must become aware. Silence is no longer an option — silence is an invitation to death. Let us unite and raise our voices against this poison!"

Addressing parents directly, he urged them to remain vigilant: "Keep a close eye on your children. If they return home late at night, examine their arms and legs — look for injection marks. This is more a parent's responsibility than the government's. After sunset, children should not roam outside unnecessarily, as these nocturnal drug dealers hunt young lives during these hours."

In conclusion, Shri Charak issued a stern warning to the administration: "If immediate and strict action is not taken against drug traffickers, we will launch a massive public movement with the people and the entire responsibility for the consequences will lie with the administration and

The Economic Offences Wing (Crime Branch Kashmir) has booked Shahid Rehman Bhat of Tulbagh Shangus, Anantnag, for allegedly defrauding several people of large sums of money on the pretext of providing high-density apple plants.

Economic Offences Wing (Crime Branch Kashmir) registers FIR against an individual namely Shahid Rehman Bhat S/o Ab. Rehman Bhat R/o Tulbagh Shangus, District Anantnag accused of defrauding numerous innocent people under the false promise of providing High Density Apple Plants.

The case pertains to several complaints received by Economic Offences Wing (Crime Branch Kashmir), alleging therein that one Shahid Rehman Bhat S/o Ab. Rehman Bhat R/o Shangus, Nowgam, District Anantnag (Proprietor of M/s AR Trading Agri Services

Pvt. Ltd) has cheated them on the pretext of providing High Density Apple Plants, it reads.

The complainants further alleged that the accused after receiving huge amount of money neither provided them High Density Apple Plants nor returned the money, and after receiving the money he has gone into hiding. The perusal of the bank transaction statements submitted by the complainants reveal that the alleged accused has grabbed amount in crores from the innocent complainants/ farmers, it reads.

The criminal act on the part of the accused Shahid Rehman Bhat S/o Ab. Rehman Bhat R/o Tulbagh Shangus, District Anantnag (Proprietor of M/s AR Trading Agri Services Pvt. Ltd) prima facie discloses commission of offence punishable U/S 318 (4) BNS 2023. Cognizance is taken and case is accordingly registered at P/S Economic Offences Wing (Crime Branch Kashmir), reads the statement.
