

Baramulla Police continue drive against illegal sand mining; tipper booked, tractor seized

BARAMULLA, AUG 7:

Continuing its sustained campaign against illegal mining and unauthorised transportation of minerals, Baramulla Police took action against vehicles found transporting sand without valid permits at different locations in the district. During naka checking at Delina, police intercepted a tipper bearing registration number JK05C-5967 carrying sand without a valid royalty permit. Legal action was initiated under the provisions of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act (MMDR Act), after which the vehicle was released in accordance with the law. In another operation, a tractor transporting sand without valid authorisation and requisite documents was intercepted in Baramulla. The vehicle was seized and legal proceedings under the MMDR Act were initiated. Baramulla Police reiterated its commitment to curbing illegal mining activities and appealed to the public to report any incidents of illegal extraction or unauthorised transportation of minerals to the nearest police station.

Baramulla Police intensify crackdown on illegal mining; motor seized, two tippers booked

BARAMULLA, AUG 7:

Baramulla Police intensified its crackdown on illegal mining by carrying out multiple enforcement operations at Delina Ghat and other areas of the district in coordination with the Geology and Mining Department. During a raid at Delina Ghat, police seized a motor allegedly being used for the illegal extraction of sand. Legal proceedings under the provisions of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act (MMDR Act) were initiated. In another operation during naka checking at Delina, a tipper bearing registration number JK05M-9076 was intercepted while transporting sand without a valid royalty permit. Necessary action under the MMDR Act was taken by the Geology and Mining Department, following which the vehicle was released as per the prescribed rules. In a separate action, Police Station Baramulla intercepted another tipper bearing registration number JK12-3169 carrying illegally extracted minerals without valid authorisation or royalty documents. The vehicle was seized in coordination with the Geology and Mining Department, and further legal proceedings under the MMDR Act were initiated. Baramulla Police reaffirmed its commitment to protecting natural resources and taking stringent action against illegal mining. The public has been urged to promptly report any instances of illegal extraction or unauthorised transportation of minerals to the nearest police station.

Police, Army and CRPF conduct joint mock drill in Ganderbal ahead of SANJY-2026

As part of the ongoing security preparedness for SANJY-2026, Jammu and Kashmir Police, in coordination with the Army and the Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), conducted a joint mock drill based on a simulated grenade-lobbing incident at the Cut-Off Point in Manigam. The exercise was aimed at assessing the operational readiness and coordinated response of the participating security agencies in handling emergency situations during the forthcoming event. The mock drill focused on key operational aspects, including area domination, civilian evacuation, casualty management, communication systems and strict adherence to Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs). The exercise demonstrated seamless coordination among the participating forces and reinforced their commitment to maintaining a high level of preparedness to ensure public safety and respond effectively to any security contingency.

Srinagar Police secure conviction in 2020 murder case; court awards life imprisonment

SRINAGAR, AUG 7:

In a significant achievement, Srinagar Police secured the conviction of an accused in a 2020 murder case registered as FIR No. 03/2020 at Police Station Maisuma, with the court sentencing the convict to rigorous imprisonment for life. The court convicted Ghulam Mohi-ud-Din Dar, a resident of Bichwara, Dalgate, Srinagar, under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code for the murder of Abdul Gani Dar, a resident of Rassu, Budgam. After hearing arguments on the quantum of sentence, the court observed that although the offence was grave and heinous, it did not fall within the category of the "rarest of rare" cases warranting capital punishment. Accordingly, the convict was sentenced to rigorous imprisonment for life and fined ₹50,000. The court directed that the fine amount, if realised, be paid to the legal heirs of the deceased as compensation. The convict was also granted the statutory benefit of set-off for the period already spent in judicial custody. The court took serious note of the fact that the crime was committed within the premises of a mosque, observing that violence in a place of worship undermines public peace, communal harmony and the sanctity of religious institutions. Considering the financial hardship faced by the victim's family, particularly the dependence of his children, the court also directed the release of ₹7 lakh as victim compensation under the Jammu and Kashmir Victim Compensation Scheme, 2019, through the Jammu and Kashmir Legal Services Authority within the stipulated time-frame. Police said the conviction was the outcome of a meticulous investigation, scientific collection of evidence and effective prosecution, reaffirming its commitment to ensuring justice and upholding the rule of law.

Srinagar Police crack major theft case, recover stolen property worth Rs 17.5 lakh

SRINAGAR, AUG 7:

Srinagar Police achieved a major breakthrough by solving a high-value theft case and recovering stolen property worth approximately Rs 17.5 lakh. The case was registered at Police Station Rainawari as FIR No. 35/2026 under Sections 305 and 331(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) following a complaint by Mohd Amin Changa of Changa Mohalla, Mir Behri, Dal, regarding a theft at his residence. During the investigation, police identified and arrested Mohd Hussain Latoo, a resident of Akhoon Mohalla, Mir Behri, Dal, Rainawari. Investigators found that he had committed the theft in connivance with two juveniles. Based on the disclosures made during interrogation, police recovered gold ornaments valued at nearly Rs 12 lakh along with Rs 2.2 lakh in cash. Further investigation revealed that part of the stolen money had been used to purchase three iPhones and a motorcycle, collectively worth about Rs 3.5 lakh, all of which were also recovered. The recovered property includes two gold bangles, eight gold rings, one gold necklace, one gold pendant set, two large earring sets, one small earring set, one pair of gold jhumkas, one wristwatch, Rs 2.2 lakh in cash, three iPhones and one motorcycle. Police said the total value of the recovered property is estimated at approximately Rs 17.5 lakh. Further investigation is underway, and additional recoveries are expected.
